CURATOR'S CORNER

This is the last in the series of articles relating to the preservation of photos.

- 1. Photocopy newspaper clippings for your archives and throw the originals away. If the original clippings have historical significance and should be kept, separate each clipping by a piece of archival-safe paper. Today's newsprint starts to disintegrate very fast. Old newspapers were made of much better quality material.
- 2. Wear white gloves when handling photos and negatives.
